

## Swedish Nuclear Society Honorary Prize 2022

### Per Lindell is designated SKS Honorary Award for 2022

The prize is awarded to those who have meritoriously promoted technological and scientific development in the peaceful field of nuclear technology or stimulated the exchange of experience and knowledge in the nuclear field or otherwise earned it.

#### **Motivation**

The Swedish Nuclear Society Honorary Prize 2022 is awarded to Mr. Per Lindell for his unique, enduring and great contributions to the nuclear industry, in Sweden and internationally.

Per is a true Swedish nuclear power pioneer. He has influenced all phases of an NPP's life cycle with his knowledge and true engagement. He started his career in 1975 as an engineer at Barsebäck NPP, where he was engaged in the commissioning and early operations. After ten years he moved further to other positions, mainly at Sydkraft AB. In 1999 he returned to Barsebäck NPP as CEO and became responsible for the challenging task to shut-down a fully operational plant for political reasons and to lead the negotiations on compensation from the Government which followed.

Through his commitment, Per has won the respect of various organizations wherein he has contributed with his profound interest to constantly improve the safety performance. He was CEO for E.ON Kärnkraft Sverige AB from 2005 to 2010 and was during those years also engaged in several supervisory boards.

Last but not least, Per is also a recognized senior expert with several international top assignments. Most importantly he is the chair of IAEA's Standing Advisory Group on Nuclear Energy (SAGNE) since 2016.
