

Nuclear for Climate

Advocating nuclear at COP27



Nuclear for Climate (N4C) is a grassroots initiative gathering over 150 associations with the goal of educating policymakers and the public about the necessity of including nuclear energy among the carbon-free solutions to climate change. It was co-founded by the European Nuclear Society (ENS), the French Nuclear Society (SFEN) and the American Nuclear Society (ANS) in 2015, ahead of the COP21 conference in Paris.

Since then, N4C international delegations took part in several international conferences, e.g. all the United Nations COP until now, where activists promoted nuclear energy as part of the solution in fighting climate change.

The delegation also hosted side events, flashmobs and participated in panel discussions with representatives from environmental NGOs, the IAEA and governmental delegations.

The N4C initiative brings together professionals and scientists of the international nuclear community, coordinated via regional and national nuclear associations and technical societies.

The last COP26 campaign has been a great success. The [N4C Final Declaration](#) has been undersigned by more than 100 NGOs and societies (among them, the Swedish Nuclear Society), supporting the [N4C Position Paper "Net zero needs nuclear"](#) and translating it in their national languages. Finally, the [N4C online petition](#) has been able to collect more than 6,000 signatures and counting.

N4C is resolute to replicate such brilliant achievements in Sharm el-Sheikh at COP27. The Delivery Team is currently organising the activities, delegates team and materials. Moreover, a series of pre-COP events are planned from September to the beginning of November. The “Route to COP27” will focus on the climate change, the ongoing emergency, the real solutions and effective actions to mitigate it. These events aim to involve not only nuclear professionals, but also climate experts and scientists.

Finally, N4C has submitted its application for the COP27 Action Hub, planning the event “Nuclear for Climate?”. This session will consist of a TED talk with an interactive format, led together by 3 experienced speakers. The core and the stimulator of the event will be a series of questions treating different climate- and nuclear-related topics.
